

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. JACKSON LEE OF TEXAS**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 7. ENHANCED LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS.**

2 (a) INCREASED RESOURCES.—The Attorney General
3 shall increase the resources available to law enforcement
4 agencies to combat the trafficking of fentanyl-laced sub-
5 stances. The Attorney General shall prioritize the fol-
6 lowing activities:

7 (1) Investigation and prosecution of individuals
8 who traffic fentanyl-laced substances.

9 (2) Disruption of the supply chain for fentanyl-
10 laced substances.

11 (3) Prevention of the importation of fentanyl-
12 laced substances into the United States.

13 (b) INTERAGENCY COORDINATION.—The Attorney
14 General shall establish an interagency task force to coordi-
15 nate the efforts of Federal, State, and local law enforce-
16 ment agencies to combat the trafficking of fentanyl-laced
17 substances.
