Page 168, insert after line 5 the following (and re-designate the succeeding provisions accordingly):

1 **SEC. 1304. VIOLATION BY OFFICEHOLDERS TREATED AS**
2 **VIOLATION OF OATH OF OFFICE FOR PUR-**
3 **POSES OF INELIGIBILITY FOR PUBLIC OF-**
4 **FICE UNDER FOURTEENTH AMENDMENT.**

5 Any person who, having previously taken an oath as
6 an officer of the United States, as a member of a State
7 legislature, or as an executive or judicial officer of any
8 State, is finally convicted of violating section 304(j) of the
9 Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (as added by sec-
10 tion 1301(a)), section 304(b)(9) of such Act (as added by
11 section 1301(b)), or section 302(j) of such Act (as added
12 by section 1302), shall be deemed to have given aid and
13 comfort to the enemies of the United States for purposes
14 of ineligibility to hold public office under section 3 of the
15 Fourteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United
16 States.
