AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-43

OFFERED BY MS. JACKSON LEE OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle D of title II, add the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

SEC. 283. CYBERSECURITY JOB SKILLS TRAINING AND EM PLOYMENT PROGRAM.

(a) PROGRAM.—Not later than 18 months after the 3 4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretaries of Edu-5 cation and Labor shall establish a "Cybersecurity Job Skills Training and Employment Program" (in this sec-6 7 tion referred to as the "Program") that shall provide— 8 (1) cybersecurity job skills training curricula for 9 use by educational institutions pursuant to the 10 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act to pro-11 vide cybersecurity technical training; and

(2) employment preparation, counseling, opportunity identification, placement, and support services
to students receiving cybersecurity training through
the Program.

16 (b) SCOPE.—In carrying out the Program under sub-17 section (a), the Secretaries shall—

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(1) generate a monthly report on the status,
 number, and location of vacancies in private sector,
 nonprofit sector, and Federal, State, and local gov ernmental cybersecurity positions nationwide;

5 (2) identify the skills needed to qualify to fill 6 positions cited in paragraph (1) and the metrics, 7 qualifications, and diagnostic tools that can accu-8 rately and reliably measure an individual's capacity 9 to perform in cybersecurity-related jobs or serve in 10 positions associated with network or computing secu-11 rity;

(3) develop a roster of Federal Government positions that may be appropriate for recipients of cybersecurity training through the Program, and make
recommendations to enable outreach to attract said
recipients to such employment opportunities;

(4) ensure that the Program's cybersecurity
training curriculum is accessible through online distance learning instruction, in-classroom instruction,
on-the-job instruction under the supervision of experienced cybersecurity staff, or other means of training and education, as determined appropriate by the
Secretaries;

(5) establish a system of outreach to recruit in-dividuals for participation in the Program, the em-

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phasis of which shall be the recruitment of trainees
 who are women, racial and ethnic minorities, vet erans, LGBTQ individuals, low-income individuals,
 and others who are socio-economically disadvantaged
 or are underrepresented in the cybersecurity indus try;

7 (6) maintain information regarding individuals
8 enrolled in the Program, their demographic charac9 teristics in relation to the specifications within para10 graph (5), and whether they accessed the Program
11 as a result of outreach and recruitment efforts or as
12 a result of other means; and

(7) annually submit to the Committee on Education and Labor of the House of Representatives
and the Committee on Health, Education, Labor,
and Pensions of the Senate a report containing information relating to Program as specified in this
subsection.

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
