At the end of the bill, add the following:

1**TITLE VI—DELAYED**2**APPLICATION**

3 SEC. 6001. DELAYED APPLICATION OF PROVISIONS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the provisions described
5 in subsection (b) shall apply with respect to any taxable
6 year that begins on or before the date described in sub7 section (c).

8 (b) PROVISIONS DESCRIBED.—The provisions de-9 scribed in this subsection are provisions enacted by this 10 Act that have the effect of lowering revenues below the 11 level projected for the corresponding time period in the 12 most recent Congressional Budget Office revenue baseline, 13 as determined by the Department of the Treasury.

14 (c) DATE DESCRIBED.—The date described in this15 subsection is the date on which—

16 (1) the Secretary of Health and Human Serv17 ices submits to Congress a report certifying that the
18 number of U.S. adults without health insurance has

- 1 not exceeded five percent for three consecutive quar-
- 2 ters; and
- 3 (2) the amount of the Federal deficit for the
 4 previous fiscal year as reported by the Congressional
 5 Budget Office is not greater than zero.

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
