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OFFERED BY MS. JACKSON LEE OF TEXAS

Page 499, after line 22, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 1632. REDUCTION OF FATALITIES.**

2 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 18 months
3 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
4 Transportation shall establish a program to reduce nation-
5 ally the incidents of fatalities involving persons engaged
6 in travel by means of bicycles, scooters, walking, jogging
7 or other forms of bi-modal transportation.

8 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—The program established
9 under subsection (a) shall—

10 (1) support local governments in developing
11 strategies for addressing motor vehicle pedestrian fa-
12 talities that engage consumer and advocacy groups
13 and other stakeholders in a process of identifying
14 problem locations, determining solutions, making de-
15 cisions about application of resources, science, and
16 technology to reduce threats to pedestrians and
17 making public results regarding pedestrian safety;
18 and

1 (2) establish a national resource for the study
2 of pedestrian motor vehicle deaths, including cata-
3 logging and indexing statistics, findings, solutions,
4 and analysis of pedestrian motor vehicle related
5 deaths and the effectiveness of solutions found for
6 these locations for easy retrieval by the public.

7 (c) PRIORITY.—In carrying out the program, the Sec-
8 retary shall give priority to locations where 2 or more pe-
9 destrian motor vehicle fatalities have been registered over
10 a 10 year period prior to the date of enactment of this
11 Act.

12 (d) REPORT.—Not later than 24 months after the
13 date of enactment of this Act, and every year thereafter,
14 the Secretary of Transportation shall submit to the com-
15 mittees of jurisdiction of the House of Representatives and
16 the Senate a report on the work of the program under
17 this section.
