3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter,
5 the Secretary of Defense and Secretary of State shall
6 jointly submit to the appropriate committees of Congress
7 a report that includes—

8 (1) a description of all transfers of logistics
9 support, supplies, defense articles and services au10 thorized under section 333 of title 10, United States
11 Code, or any other applicable provision of law;

(2) a description of all security assistance, as
such term is defined for purposes of section 520B of
the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C.
2304), authorized under the Arms Export Control
Act (22 U.S.C. 2751 et seq.) or part II of the Foreign Assistance Act (22 U.S.C. 2301 et seq.) at the

23	(b) Sources.—In preparing the reports required by

3 (c) FORM.—Each report required by this section shall
4 be submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classified annex. The unclassified portions of each such report
6 shall be made available to the public concurrently with the
7 submission to Congress.

8 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

9 (1) the term "civilian harm" means civilian in-10 jury, death, damage to civilian objects, and any 11 other harms caused as a result of the use of force; 12 and

13 (2) the term "appropriate committees of Con14 gress" means—

(A) the Committee on Foreign Affairs, the
Committee on Armed Services, and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives; and
