

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-10**  
**OFFERED BY MS. JACOBS OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle C of title XVIII, add the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_. REPORT ON A STRATEGY FOR JUSTICE AND AC-**  
2 **COUNTABILITY OF THE NIGERIAN ARMED**  
3 **FORCES RELATED TO CIVILIAN CASUALTIES**  
4 **AND HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS; PROHIBI-**  
5 **TION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the  
7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State  
8 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees  
9 a report on a strategy for justice and accountability of  
10 the Nigerian Armed Forces related to civilian casualties  
11 and human rights violations.

12 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-  
13 quired by subsection (a) shall include the following:

14 (1) A plan to urge the Government of Nigeria  
15 to complete transparent and credible investigations  
16 of civilian casualties and human rights violations re-  
17 sulting from Nigerian Armed Forces operations.

18 (2) An assessment of the willingness, capability,  
19 and likelihood of the Nigerian Army, Nigerian Navy,

1 and Nigerian Air Force undertaking such investiga-  
2 tions and making progress on justice and account-  
3 ability and greater respect for human rights.

4 (c) UPDATES.—Not later than 180 days after the  
5 date on which the report required by subsection (a) is sub-  
6 mitted to the appropriate congressional committees, and  
7 every 180 days thereafter, the Secretary of State shall  
8 submit to the appropriate congressional committees an up-  
9 date on progress to implement the plan required by sub-  
10 section (b)(1).

11 (d) PROHIBITION.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—If the Secretary of State de-  
13 termines that the Government of Nigeria has not  
14 made significant progress to achieve the goals of the  
15 plan required by subsection (b)(1), any export li-  
16 cense for security or military equipment to the Gov-  
17 ernment of Nigeria may not be authorized and any  
18 security assistance training, including training under  
19 section 333 of title 10, United States Code, may not  
20 be provided until the date on which the Secretary  
21 determines that the Government of Nigeria has  
22 made significant progress to achieve such goals.

23 (2) CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION.—If the  
24 Secretary determines that the Government of Nige-  
25 ria has made significant progress to achieve the

1 goals of the plan required by subsection (b)(1), the  
2 Secretary shall submit a detailed explanation for  
3 such determination to the appropriate congressional  
4 committees

5 (e) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-  
6 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
7 sional committees” means the Committee on Foreign Af-  
8 fairs of the House of Representatives and the Committee  
9 on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
