

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1**  
**OFFERED BY MR. JAMES OF MICHIGAN**

After section 20309, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 20310. NATIONAL STRATEGY TO RE-SHORE MINERAL**  
2 **SUPPLY CHAINS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of enactment of this Act, the United States Geologi-  
5 cal Survey, in consultation with the Secretaries of De-  
6 fense, Energy, and State, shall—

7 (1) identify mineral commodities that—

8 (A) serve a critical purpose to the national  
9 security of the United States, including with re-  
10 spect to military, defense, and strategic mobility  
11 applications; and

12 (B) are at highest risk of supply chain dis-  
13 ruption due to the domestic or global actions of  
14 any covered entity, including price-fixing, sys-  
15 temic acquisition and control of global mineral  
16 resources and processing, refining, and smelting  
17 capacity, and undereutting the fair market  
18 value of such resources; and

19 (2) develop a national strategy for bolstering  
20 supply chains in the United States for the mineral

1 commodities identified under paragraph (1), includ-  
2 ing through the enactment of new national policies  
3 and the utilization of current authorities, to increase  
4 capacity and efficiency of domestic mining, refining,  
5 processing, and manufacturing of such mineral com-  
6 modities.

7 (b) COVERED ENTITY.—In this section, the term  
8 “covered entity” means an entity that—

9 (1) is subject to the jurisdiction or direction of  
10 the People’s Republic of China;

11 (2) is directly or indirectly operating on behalf  
12 of the People’s Republic of China; or

13 (3) is owned by, directly or indirectly controlled  
14 by, or otherwise subject to the influence of the Peo-  
15 ple’s Republic of China.
