

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-

OFFERED BY MR. JAMES OF MICHIGAN

At the end of title XVIII, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON SECURITY AND ECONOMIC EFFECTS**

2 **ON SUPPLY CHAIN OF SOO LOCKS, MICHIGAN.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
5 tation, in coordination with the Commandant of the Coast
6 Guard and the Secretary of Defense, shall submit to the
7 appropriate committees of Congress a report that—

8 (1) highlights any security deficiencies that
9 exist with respect to the Soo Locks in Sault Ste.
10 Marie, Michigan;

11 (2) highlights the supply chain, logistical, and
12 economic effects that would result in the event of a
13 malfunction or failure of the Soo Locks and how
14 such effects would impact the region surrounding
15 the Soo Locks and the United States;

16 (3) highlights any potential domestic or inter-
17 national threats to the integrity of the Soo Locks;

1 (4) details the current security structure of the
2 Coast Guard and any other relevant Federal, State,
3 or local agency to protect the Soo Locks; and

4 (5) provides any recommendations, and cost es-
5 timates for such recommendations, for—

6 (A) strengthening the security of the Soo
7 Locks; and

8 (B) reducing the impacts to the supply
9 chain of the United States that would result in
10 the event of a malfunction or failure of the Soo
11 Locks.

12 (b) APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF CONGRESS DE-
13 FINED.—In this Act, the term “appropriate committees of
14 Congress” means—

15 (1) the Committee on Transportation and In-
16 frastructure of the House of Representatives;

17 (2) the Committee on Commerce, Transpor-
18 tation, and Science of the Senate; and

19 (3) the Committee on Environment and Public
20 Works of the Senate.
