

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-36
OFFERED BY MR. JAMES OF MICHIGAN

Amend section 1725 to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 1725. CERTIFICATION AND REPORTS ON SOUTH AFRI-**

2 **CA.**

3 (a) **PRESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATION.—**

4 (1) **IN GENERAL.—**Not later than 30 days after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act, the President,
6 in consultation with the Secretary of State and the
7 Secretary of Defense, shall certify to the appropriate
8 congressional committees and release publicly an un-
9 classified determination explicitly stating whether
10 South Africa has engaged in activities that under-
11 mine United States national security or foreign pol-
12 icy interests.

13 (2) **REPORT.—**The certification required under
14 paragraph (1) shall be accompanied by an unclassi-
15 fied report, with a classified annex if the President
16 considers such as necessary, providing a justification
17 for the determination made pursuant to such para-
18 graph.

19 (b) **REVIEW OF BILATERAL RELATIONSHIP.—**

1 (1) FULL REVIEW.—The President, in consulta-
2 tion with the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of
3 State, the Administrator of the United States Agen-
4 cy for International Development, the United States
5 Ambassador to South Africa, and the heads of such
6 other Federal departments and agencies that play a
7 substantial role in United States relations with
8 South Africa, shall conduct a review of the bilateral
9 relationship between the United States and South
10 Africa.

11 (2) REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after
12 the date of the enactment of this Act, the President
13 shall submit to the appropriate congressional com-
14 mittees a report that includes the findings of the re-
15 view required by paragraph (1).

16 (c) SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after
18 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
19 of Defense shall submit to the appropriate congress-
20 sional committees a report on United States defense
21 cooperation with the Government of South Africa.

22 (2) ELEMENTS.—The report required under
23 paragraph (1) shall also include the following:

24 (A) An overview of United States defense
25 cooperation with the Government of South Afri-

1 ca, including military exercises, arms sales, and
2 international military education and training.

3 (B) An assessment of defense cooperation
4 between the Government of South Africa and
5 the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran,
6 the Government of the People's Republic of
7 China, and the Government of the Russian
8 Federation.

9 (3) FORM.—The report required under para-
10 graph (1) shall be transmitted in an unclassified
11 form and may contain a classified annex.

12 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
13 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
14 gressional committees” means the congressional defense
15 committees, the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
16 House of Representatives, and the Committee on Foreign
17 Relations of the Senate.
