

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10
OFFERED BY MS. JAYAPAL OF WASHINGTON

At the end of subtitle B of title XVIII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 18__ . DEPARTMENT OF STATE REPORT ON RISK AS-**
2 **SOCIATED WITH CERTAIN ARMS TRANSFERS**
3 **TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES.**

4 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall
6 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a re-
7 port containing an analysis of the risk associated with the
8 transfers of firearms to foreign countries and, in par-
9 ticular, the risk that such transferred firearms (regardless
10 of whether the firearm is manufactured by the Secretary
11 of Defense or by a nongovernmental manufacturer) may
12 be transferred to an unauthorized end user or for an end
13 use that is in violation of—

14 (1) section 620M of the Foreign Assistance Act
15 of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2378d) or section 362 of title
16 10, United States Code (commonly referred to as
17 the “Leahy laws”) or any other applicable provision
18 of law; or

1 (2) internationally recognized human rights.

2 (b) MATTERS.—At a minimum, the risk analysis con-
3 ducted pursuant to subsection (a) shall include, with re-
4 spect to each foreign country to which firearms have been
5 transferred from the United States since 2000 or that is
6 an official ally of the United States, an analysis of the
7 following:

8 (1) The strength of the democracy of the coun-
9 try.

10 (2) The records of human rights abuses within
11 the country.

12 (3) The levels of corruption and prevalence of
13 organized crime within the country.

14 (4) The prevalence of state violence against ci-
15 vilians perpetrated by the law enforcement or armed
16 forces of the country.

17 (5) The levels of economic inequality within the
18 country.

19 (c) PUBLICATION.—The Secretary of State shall pub-
20 lish the report under subsection (a), in whole or in part,
21 on a publically accessible website of the Department of
22 State.

23 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
24 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
25 gressional committees” means—

1 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
2 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives; and

4 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
5 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
