At the end of title VIII, add the following:

1	SEC PROJECT GRANT APPLICATION APPROVAL
2	CONDITIONED ON ASSURANCES ABOUT AIR-

4	(a) In General.—Section 47107(a) of title 49,
5	United States Code, is amended—
6	(1) by amending paragraph (1) to read as fol-
7	lows:
8	"(1) the airport will be available for public use
9	on reasonable conditions and without unjust dis-
10	crimination and the airport proprietor will take all
11	reasonable and practicable steps to accommodate re-
12	quests for access to the terminal and other facili-
13	ties;";
14	(2) in paragraph (20) by striking "; and" and
15	inserting a semicolon;
16	(3) in paragraph (21) by striking the period
17	and inserting a semicolon; and
18	(4) by adding at the end the following:

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"(22) any airport serving 0.25 percent or more

2	of the nation's total annual enplanements (calculated
3	on a rolling five-year average) and with more than
4	50 percent of passengers handled by one or two air
5	carriers (again on a rolling five-year average) must
6	submit any proposed lease, lease amendment, or
7	lease extension (including carryover provisions) to
8	the FAA for advance approval in order to ensure
9	that the public interest is served with respect to the
10	airport's ability to expand capacity and accommo-
11	date air carriers.".
12	(b) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 24 months after
13	the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-
14	portation shall publish in the Federal Register final regu-
15	lations describing the standards that the Department will
16	use to determine whether reasonable access is being pro-
17	vided by an airport sponsor in accordance with
18	47107(a)(1) of title 49, United States Code, and processes
19	for enforcing such requirement.
20	(c) COMMON USE.—Section 47107 of title 49, United
21	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
22	lowing:
23	"(x) Prioritization.—The Secretary shall prioritize
24	future Federal funding, particularly discretionary terminal
25	grants applied to terminal projects for airports maintain-

- 1 ing some minimum level of available common use gate ca-
- 2 pacity, and establish tighter criteria for passenger facility
- 3 charge revenues supporting terminal projects.".
