SEC. _____. (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 101 of title
 2 10, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end

6 "(a) COMBAT TRAUMA INJURIES.—(1) Not later 7 than October 1, 2020, the Secretary of Defense shall com-8 plete the development, testing, and validation of human-9 based training methods for the purpose of training mem-10 bers of the armed forces in the treatment of combat trau-11 ma injuries with the goal of replacing live animal-based 12 training methods.

13 "(2) Not later than October 1, 2022, the Sec14 retary—

"(A) shall only use human-based training
methods for the purpose of training members of
the armed forces in the treatment of combat
trauma injuries; and

1 "(B) may not use animals for such pur-2 pose.

3 "(b) ANNUAL REPORTS.—Not later than October 1, 4 2018, and each year thereafter, the Secretary shall submit 5 to the congressional defense committees a report on the 6 development and implementation of human-based training 7 methods for the purpose of training members of the armed 8 forces in the treatment of combat trauma injuries under 9 this section. "(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section: 10

11 "(1) The term 'combat trauma injuries' means
12 severe injuries likely to occur during combat, includ13 ing—

14 "(A) hemorrhage;

15 "(B) tension pneumothorax;

16 "(C) amputation resulting from blast in-17 jury;

18 "(D) compromises to the airway; and

19 "(E) other injuries.

"(2) The term 'human-based training methods'
means, with respect to training individuals in medical treatment, the use of systems and devices that
do not use animals, including—

24 "(A) simulators;

6	"(3) The term 'partial task trainers' means
