

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. JOHNSON OF SOUTH DAKOTA

At the end of subtitle E of title I, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 1___ . ASSESSMENT OF DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**
2 **DISPLAY SUPPLY CHAIN VULNERABILITIES.**

3 (a) **ASSESSMENT REQUIRED.**—The Secretary of De-
4 fense, in coordination with the Secretary of Commerce,
5 shall conduct an assessment of supply chain vulnerabilities
6 related to displays used in Department of Defense weapon
7 systems and platforms.

8 (b) **ELEMENTS.**—The assessment shall include—

9 (1) identification of defense systems dependent
10 on displays sourced from the People’s Republic of
11 China or Taiwan;

12 (2) assessment of supply disruption risks and
13 potential operational impacts;

14 (3) evaluation of domestic or allied manufac-
15 turing capabilities for advanced display technologies;

16 (4) analysis of emerging display technologies,
17 including microLED displays; and

1 (5) recommendations for reducing foreign de-
2 pendence in critical display applications.

3 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
5 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
6 port on the results of the assessment conducted under sub-
7 section (a).

8 (d) FORM.—The report under subsection (c) shall be
9 submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classi-
10 fied annex.
