## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8790, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. JOHNSON OF SOUTH DAKOTA

Add at the end the following:

## 1 SEC. 307. EXEMPTION FOR PREVIOUSLY ANALYZED AREAS 2 OF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The requirements under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 4 5 et seq.) or division A of subtitle 54, United States Code, 6 shall not apply to an application for a communications use 7 authorization on National Forest System lands, including National Forest System lands on which authorized utili-8 9 ties, communications facilities, powerline facilities or roads have been installed, if— 10

- (1) the communications equipment is located inor on existing infrastructure; or
- 13 (2) the communications facility is located on
  14 previously analyzed areas of National Forest System
  15 lands.

(b) NO ADDITIONAL CONSULTATION REQUIRED
UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.—Notwithstanding
any other provision of law, the Secretary shall not be required to reinitiate consultation of the requirements under
the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C.

4321 et seq.) or division A of subtitle 54, United States
 Code, for an application for a communications use author ization on previously analyzed areas of National Forest
 System lands if new information concerning a previously
 analyzed area of National Forest Service land becomes
 available.

(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

8 (1) COMMUNICATIONS FACILITY; COMMUNICA-9 TIONS USE AUTHORIZATION.—The terms "commu-10 nications facility" and "communications use author-11 ization" have the meanings given the terms, respec-12 tively, in section 8705 of the Agriculture Improve-13 ment Act of 2018 (43 U.S.C. 1761a).

14 (2) PREVIOUSLY ANALYZED AREAS OF NA15 TIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS.—The term "pre16 viously analyzed areas of National Forest System
17 lands" means any National Forest Service land with
18 respect to which the Secretary has—

- 19 (A) granted, issued, and executed a com-20 munications use authorization; and
- 21 (B) conducted sufficient environmental or22 historical reviews.

(3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
 the Secretary of Agriculture, acting through the
 Chief of the Forest Service.
