At the end of title IX, add the following new subtitle:

Subtitle D—DESIGNATION OF THE NAVY AND MARINE CORPS

3 SEC. 931. REDESIGNATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE
4 NAVY AS THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY
5 AND MARINE CORPS.

6 (a) REDESIGNATION OF MILITARY DEPARTMENT.—
7 The military department designated as the Department of
8 the Navy is redesignated as the Department of the Navy
9 and Marine Corps.

10 (b) Redesignation of Secretary and Other11 Statutory Offices.—

(1) SECRETARY.—The position of the Secretary
of the Navy is redesignated as the Secretary of the
Navy and Marine Corps.

(2) OTHER STATUTORY OFFICES.—The positions of the Under Secretary of the Navy, the four
Assistant Secretaries of the Navy, and the General
Counsel of the Department of the Navy are redesig-

nated as the Under Secretary of the Navy and Ma rine Corps, the Assistant Secretaries of the Navy
 and Marine Corps, and the General Counsel of the
 Department of the Navy and Marine Corps, respec tively.

6 SEC. 932. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS TO TITLE 10, UNITED 7 STATES CODE.

8 (a) DEFINITION OF "MILITARY DEPARTMENT".—
9 Paragraph (8) of section 101(a) of title 10, United States
10 Code, is amended to read as follows:

"(8) The term 'military department' means the
Department of the Army, the Department of the
Navy and Marine Corps, and the Department of the
Air Force.".

(b) ORGANIZATION OF DEPARTMENT.—The text of
section 5011 of such title is amended to read as follows:
"The Department of the Navy and Marine Corps is separately organized under the Secretary of the Navy and Marine Corps.".

(c) POSITION OF SECRETARY.—Section 5013(a)(1) of
such title is amended by striking "There is a Secretary
of the Navy" and inserting "There is a Secretary of the
Navy and Marine Corps".

24 (d) Chapter Headings.—

3

(1) The heading of chapter 503 of such title is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "CHAPTER 503—DEPARTMENT OF THE 4 NAVY AND MARINE CORPS".

5 (2) The heading of chapter 507 of such title is6 amended to read as follows:

7 "CHAPTER 507—COMPOSITION OF THE DE8 PARTMENT OF THE NAVY AND MARINE 9 CORPS".

10 (e) Other Amendments.—

11 (1) Title 10, United States Code, is amended by 12 striking "Department of the Navy" and "Secretary of the Navy" each place they appear other than as 13 14 specified in subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d) (includ-15 ing in section headings, subsection captions, tables 16 of chapters, and tables of sections) and inserting 17 "Department of the Navy and Marine Corps" and 18 "Secretary of the Navy and Marine Corps", respec-19 tively, in each case with the matter inserted to be in 20 the same typeface and typestyle as the matter strick-21 en.

22 (2)(A) Sections 5013(f), 5014(b)(2), 5016(a),
23 5017(2), 5032(a), and 5042(a) of such title are
24 amended by striking "Assistant Secretaries of the

Navy" and inserting "Assistant Secretaries of the
 Navy and Marine Corps".

3 (B) The heading of section 5016 of such title,
4 and the item relating to such section in the table of
5 sections at the beginning of chapter 503 of such
6 title, are each amended by inserting "and Marine
7 Corps" after "of the Navy", with the matter in8 serted in each case to be in the same typeface and
9 typestyle as the matter amended.

10SEC. 933. OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW AND OTHER REF-11ERENCES.

(a) TITLE 37, UNITED STATES CODE.—Title 37,
United States Code, is amended by striking "Department
of the Navy" and "Secretary of the Navy" each place they
appear and inserting "Department of the Navy and Marine Corps" and "Secretary of the Navy and Marine
Corps", respectively.

18 (b) OTHER REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law 19 other than in title 10 or title 37, United States Code, or in any regulation, document, record, or other paper of the 20 21 United States, to the Department of the Navy shall be 22 considered to be a reference to the Department of the 23 Navy and Marine Corps. Any such reference to an office 24 specified in section 931(b) shall be considered to be a ref-25 erence to that officer as redesignated by that section.

1 SEC. 934. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 This subtitle and the amendments made by this sub3 title shall take effect on the first day of the first month
4 beginning more than 60 days after the date of the enact5 ment of this Act.
