

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MURPHY OF NORTH CAROLINA**

At the end of subtitle B of title VII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7\_\_\_ . JOINT UNIFORM CREDENTIALING AND PRIVI-**  
2 **LEGING SYSTEM FOR MEDICAL PROVIDERS**  
3 **AT THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND THE**  
4 **DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

5 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after the date  
6 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense and  
7 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in consultation with the  
8 Domestic Policy Council, shall jointly submit to the Com-  
9 mittees on Armed Services and Veterans' Affairs of the  
10 House of Representatives and the Senate a report on the  
11 medical provider credentialing and privileging systems in  
12 use by each Department. Such report shall include each  
13 of the following:

- 14 (1) A description of the scope and scale of each  
15 system.
- 16 (2) A description of the type of data stored on  
17 each system.

1           (3) A description of the portability of provider  
2           credentialing and privileging information under each  
3           system.

4           (4) A description of the interoperability between  
5           provider credentialing systems.

6           (5) A description of the risk management sys-  
7           tem, adverse actions, and governance of each sys-  
8           tem.

9           (6) A description of the limitations and gaps in  
10          the interoperability and administration of each sys-  
11          tem.

12          (7) Recommendations for scaling each system  
13          and addressing gaps in the interoperability and ad-  
14          ministration of such system, with the goal of achiev-  
15          ing a single, uniform system to be used by both De-  
16          partments.

17          (b) SELECTION.—Not later than January 1, 2027,  
18          the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of Veterans  
19          Affairs, in consultation with the Domestic Policy Council,  
20          shall jointly select one system from the systems in use by  
21          the Departments to serve as the joint uniform  
22          credentialing and privileging system for both the Depart-  
23          ment of Defense and the Department of Veterans Affairs.

24          (c) CAPABILITY OF SYSTEM.—The Secretary of De-  
25          fense and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall ensure

1 that such joint uniform credentialing and privileging sys-  
2 tem has the capability to import and share provider  
3 credentialing and privileging information.

4 (d) CERTIFICATION OF IMPLEMENTATION.—Not  
5 later than January 1, 2028, the Secretary of Defense and  
6 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall jointly submit to  
7 the Committees on Armed Services and Veterans' Affairs  
8 of the House of Representatives and the Senate a written  
9 certificate that such joint uniform credentialing and privi-  
10 leging system has been implemented and is operational.
