

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-10**  
**OFFERED BY MS. KAMLAGER-DOVE OF**  
**CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVIII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON THE FUTURE OF RUSSIAN PRIVATE**  
2 **SECURITY FORCES IN AFRICA.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State  
5 shall submit a report to the appropriate congressional  
6 committees on the impact of the Wagner Group’s June  
7 2023 confrontation with the Russian military and related  
8 subsequent events on Wagner Group or other Russian pri-  
9 vate military company (referred to in this section as  
10 “PMC”) operations in Africa, including the following:

11 (1) Changes to the Wagner Group’s deploy-  
12 ment, readiness, and sources and access to funding  
13 for operations in Africa, including contributions  
14 from other states or third parties.

15 (2) The effects of changes to the Wagner  
16 Group’s leadership, structure, and relationship with

1 the Russian state on Russian state and Russian  
2 PMC operations and influence in Africa.

3 (3) How any such changes have affected the  
4 stability, security, and political dynamics of African  
5 countries where the Wagner Group has been active,  
6 including the Central African Republic, Libya, Mali,  
7 and Sudan.

8 (4) How any such changes impact the strategy  
9 and engagement of the United States with foreign  
10 governments and local populations in countries  
11 where Wagner Group and Russian PMC forces have  
12 been active, including any related funding allocations  
13 and legal authorities under which such engagement  
14 is conducted.

15 (b) FORMAT.—The report under this section shall be  
16 submitted in unclassified form, and may include a classi-  
17 fied appendix.

18 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—  
19 The term “appropriate congressional committees” means  
20 the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
21 resentatives and the Committee on Foreign Relations of  
22 the Senate.
