1	At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the fol-

3	SEC. 17 HIGH SCHOOL EXCHANGE PROGRAMS.
4	(a) Establishment.—The Secretary of State, act-
5	ing through the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Af-
6	fairs, shall carry out, in each fiscal year, the following per-
7	manent programs of the Department of State:
8	(1) The Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange,
9	first established in 1983, which shall, in partnership
10	with the Government of Germany, create opportuni-
11	ties for study and work abroad for United States
12	and German high school students, recent high school
13	students with a vocational interest, and young pro-
14	fessionals.
15	(2) The Future Leaders Exchange Program,
16	first established in 1993, which shall offer merit-
17	based scholarships to high school students in the
18	South Caucasus region, the Baltic region, Central
19	Asia, Central Europe, Ukraine, and Moldova to en-

1	able them to attend high school in the United States
2	for an academic year while living with a host family.
3	(3) The Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and
4	Study Program, first established in 2002, which
5	shall create merit-based opportunities for—
6	(A) students from the United States to en-
7	able them to study in the Western Balkans re-
8	gion, the Middle East, North Africa, or South
9	Asia; and
10	(B) students from predominantly Muslim
11	countries in the regions referred to in subpara-
12	graph (A) to enable them to attend high school
13	in the United States, while living with a host
14	family and engaging in community service and
15	civic education opportunities.
16	(4) The National Security Language Initiative
17	for Youth, first established in 2006, which shall en-
18	able high school students from the United States to
19	study (abroad or online) critical languages that are
20	necessary to strengthen United States' national se-
21	curity and economic competitiveness.
22	(b) Program Activities.—Each initiative described
23	in subsection (a) shall include, to the extent practicable—
24	(1) full academic-year scholarships for United
25	States and partner-country high school students;

1	(2) placement with host families in the partner
2	country or the United States, as applicable;
3	(3) enrollment and attendance at local schools;
4	and
5	(4) programming to foster cross-cultural under-
6	standing, leadership, and civic engagement.
