At the end of subtitle B of title X, insert the following new section:

1	SEC. 10 SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING NAMING OF
2	NAVAL VESSEL FOR ADMIRAL ALENE DUERK.
3	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
4	gress that the Secretary of the Navy should name a vessel
5	of the United States Navy the "U.S.S. Admiral Alene
6	Duerk" in honor of Admiral Alene Duerk, for the acts of
7	valor described in subsection (b).
8	(b) Acts of Valor Described.—The acts of valor
9	described in this subsection are the actions of Alene
10	Duerk, as a member of the United States Navy, as follows:
11	(1) Following Admiral Duerk's birth in Defi-
12	ance, Ohio and graduation from Toledo Hospital
13	School of Nursing, she received a commission on
14	January 23, 1943, and was appointed as an ensign
15	in the Nurse Corps of the U.S. Naval Reserve.
16	(2) During World War II, she was assigned as
17	a Ward Nurse at the Naval Medical Center Ports-
18	mouth, Portsmouth, Virginia, and at the Naval Hos-
19	pital, Bethesda Maryland where she cared for

1	wounded members of the United States Armed
2	Forces. In 1945, she was stationed on the USS Be-
3	nevolence in the Pacific Theater (AH-13) where she
4	treated casualties from Third Fleet operations until
5	the end of the war.
6	(3) After the war, she progressed in rank and
7	served in positions of increasing responsibility in
8	both the Navy Reserves and Active Duty including
9	posts in Michigan, Virginia, Pennsylvania, Illinois
10	the Philippines, Japan, California, and Washington
11	D.C. Her dedication and inspirational service cul-
12	minated with her historic selection for the rank of
13	Rear Admiral on April 16, 1972, as the first woman
14	to become a flag officer.
15	(4) Rear Admiral Duerk was awarded the
16	Naval Reserve Medal, American Campaign Medal
17	the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal with Bronze
18	Star, the World War II Victory Medal, the Navy Oc-
19	cupation Service Medal, Asia Clasp, and the Na-
20	tional Defense Service Medal with Bronze Star.
