

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-40

OFFERED BY MS. KAPTUR OF OHIO

On page 128, line 4, strike “\$250,000,000” and insert “\$550,000,000”.

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1 SEC. __. For an additional amount for “OPERATION
2 AND MAINTENANCE, DEFENSE-WIDE”, for the Defense Se-
3 curity Cooperation Agency, \$300,000,000, to remain
4 available until September 30, 2026, shall be for the
5 Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative: *Provided*, That
6 such funds shall be available to the Secretary of Defense,
7 with the concurrence of the Secretary of State, to provide
8 assistance, including training; equipment; lethal assist-
9 ance; logistics support, supplies and services; salaries and
10 stipends; sustainment; and intelligence support to the mili-
11 tary and national security forces of Ukraine, and to other
12 forces or groups recognized by and under the authority
13 of the Government of Ukraine, including governmental en-
14 tities within Ukraine, engaged in resisting Russian aggres-
15 sion against Ukraine for replacement of any weapons or
16 articles provided to the Government of Ukraine from the
17 inventory of the United States, and to recover or dispose

1 of equipment procured using funds made available in this
2 section in this or prior Acts: *Provided further*, That the
3 Secretary of Defense shall, not less than 15 days prior
4 to obligating funds made available in this section, notify
5 the congressional defense committees in writing of the de-
6 tails of any such obligation: *Provided further*, That the
7 Secretary of Defense shall, not more than 60 days after
8 such notification is made, inform such committees if such
9 funds have not been obligated and the reasons therefor:
10 *Provided further*, That the Secretary of Defense shall con-
11 sult with such committees in advance of the provision of
12 support provided to other forces or groups recognized by
13 and under the authority of the Government of Ukraine:
14 *Provided further*, That the United States may accept
15 equipment procured using funds made available in this
16 section in this or prior Acts transferred to the security
17 forces of Ukraine and returned by such forces to the
18 United States: *Provided further*, That equipment procured
19 using funds made available in this section in this or prior
20 Acts, and not yet transferred to the military or national
21 security forces of Ukraine or to other assisted entities, or
22 returned by such forces or other assisted entities to the
23 United States, may be treated as stocks of the Depart-
24 ment of Defense upon written notification to the congres-
25 sional defense committees: *Provided further*, That any no-

1 tification of funds made available in this section shall
2 specify an estimated timeline for the delivery of defense
3 articles and defense services provided and shall identify
4 if any equipment provided requires enhanced end-use mon-
5 itoring: *Provided further*, That the Secretary of Defense
6 may accept and retain contributions, including money,
7 personal property, and services, from foreign governments
8 and other entities, to carry out assistance authorized for
9 the Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative in this section:
10 *Provided further*, That the Secretary of Defense shall no-
11 tify the congressional defense committees in writing upon
12 the receipt and upon the obligation of any contribution,
13 delineating the sources and amounts of the funds received
14 and the specific use of such contributions: *Provided fur-*
15 *ther*, That contributions of money for the purposes pro-
16 vided herein from any foreign government or other entity
17 may be credited to this account, to remain available until
18 September 30, 2026, and used for such purposes: *Provided*
19 *further*, That the Secretary of Defense shall provide quar-
20 terly reports to the congressional defense committees on
21 the use and status of funds made available in this section.
