

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4665, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. KEAN OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), add the following:

1 REPORT ON FREE MOVEMENT OF PEOPLE AND GOODS
2 THROUGH THE LACHIN CORRIDOR

3 SEC. __. (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense
4 of Congress that the free and open movement of people
5 and goods through the Lachin Corridor, pursuant to the
6 2020 ceasefire agreement between Armenia and Azer-
7 baijan, is critical to any peaceful solution to the conflict
8 between the two countries.

9 (b) REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.—Not later than 30
10 days after the date of the enactment of this Act and every
11 30 days thereafter, the Secretary of State shall submit to
12 the appropriate congressional committees a report on the
13 following:

14 (1) The status of movement of people and
15 goods through the Lachin Corridor.

16 (2) To what extent the Government of Azer-
17 baijan is inhibiting such free and open movement of
18 people and goods through the corridor.

1 (3) To what extent the Government of Azer-
2 bajjan's actions at the Lachin Corridor are under-
3 mining the peace process between Armenia and
4 Azerbaijan.

5 (4) The impact of the Government of Azer-
6 bajjan's actions at the Lachin Corridor on the status
7 of the humanitarian situation in Nagorno-Karabakh.

8 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (b)
9 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
10 a classified annex provided separately, if needed.

11 (d) BRIEFING.—The Secretary of State shall brief
12 the appropriate congressional committees not later than
13 30 days after the date of enactment of this Act on the
14 report required by subsection (b).

15 (e) SUNSET.—This section shall terminate on the
16 earlier of—

17 (1) the date that is 2 years after the date of en-
18 actment of this Act; or

19 (2) the date on which the Secretary of State
20 makes a certification to the appropriate congres-
21 sional committees that free and open movement of
22 people and goods through the Lachin Corridor has
23 been fully restored.

1 (f) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
2 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
3 sional committees” means—

4 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
5 House of Representatives; and

6 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations of the
7 Senate.
