AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4665, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. KEAN OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of the bill (before the short title), add the following:

1	CERTIFICATION OF UNITED STATES ASSISTANCE ON
2	NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN ARMENIA AND AZERBAIJAN
3	Sec (a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense
4	of Congress that—
5	(1) continued negotiations between Armenia
6	and Azerbaijan are critical to normalizing relations
7	and ending the long-standing conflict between the
8	two countries;
9	(2) the United States should play a leading role
10	in facilitating those negotiations; and
11	(3) all stakeholders must seize this critical mo-
12	ment to secure peace and prosperity for the people
13	of Armenia and Azerbaijan.
14	(b) Report.—Not later than 60 days after the date
15	of enactment of this Act and every 60 days thereafter,
16	the Secretary of State shall submit to the appropriate con-
17	gressional committees a report on the extent to which, if
18	any, United States assistance to the Government of Azer-
19	baijan—

1	(1) has undermined or hampered ongoing ef-
2	forts to negotiate a peaceful settlement between Ar-
3	menia and Azerbaijan; or
4	(2) has been used for offensive purposes against
5	Armenia.
6	(c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (b)
7	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
8	a classified annex provided separately, if needed.
9	(d) Briefing.—The Secretary of State, in coordina-
10	tion with the Secretary of Defense, shall brief the appro-
11	priate congressional committees not later than 30 days
12	after the date of issuance of a report required by sub-
13	section (b) on the contents of such report.
14	(e) Sunset.—This section shall terminate on the
15	earlier of—
16	(1) the date that is 2 years after the date of the
17	enactment of this Act; or
18	(2) the date on which the Secretary of State
19	submits a certification to the appropriate Congres-
20	sional Committees that Armenia and Azerbaijan
21	have reached a comprehensive peace agreement to
22	end their long-standing conflict.
23	(f) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
24	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
25	sional committees" means—

1	(1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
2	Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep-
3	resentatives; and
4	(2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
5	the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate.
