

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4

OFFERED BY MR. KEATING OF MASSACHUSETTS

Page 109, after line 15, insert the following:

1 (a) **WORKFORCE READINESS.**—The Administrator of
2 the Federal Aviation Administration shall coordinate with
3 government, educational institutions, labor organizations
4 representing aviation maintenance workers, and busi-
5 nesses to develop guidance or model curricula for aviation
6 maintenance technician schools certificated under part
7 147 of title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations to en-
8 sure workforce readiness for industry needs, including cur-
9 ricula related to training in avionics, troubleshooting, and
10 other areas of industry needs.

11 (1) Not later than 1 year after the date of en-
12 actment of this Act, the Administrator shall publish
13 the guidance or model curricula.

14 (2) The Administrator shall publish updates to
15 the guidance or model curricula at least once every
16 2 years from the date of initial publication.
