

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. KEATING OF MASSACHUSETTS

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 17 ____ . MODIFICATIONS TO CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW**
2 **OF SANCTIONS WITH RESPECT TO THE RUS-**
3 **SIAN FEDERATION.**

4 (a) EXPANSION OF SANCTIONS SUBJECT TO RE-
5 VIEW.—Section 216(a)(2)(B)(i) of the Countering Amer-
6 ica’s Adversaries Through Sanctions Act (22 U.S.C.
7 9511(a)(2)(B)(i)) is amended—

8 (1) in subclause (II), by striking “; or” and in-
9 serting a semicolon;

10 (2) in subclause (III), by striking “; and” and
11 inserting “; or”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(IV) any Executive order ad-
14 dressing the national emergency de-
15 clared in Executive Order 14024 (50
16 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to blocking
17 property with respect to specified
18 harmful foreign activities of the Gov-
19 ernment of the Russian Federation).”.

1 (b) REVIEW OF ENERGY-RELATED ACTIONS.—Sec-
2 tion 216(a)(2) of the Countering America’s Adversaries
3 Through Sanctions Act (22 U.S.C. 9511(a)(2)) is amend-
4 ed—

5 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

6 (A) in clause (ii), by striking “; or” and in-
7 serting a semicolon;

8 (B) in clause (iii), by striking the period at
9 the end and inserting “; or”; and

10 (C) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(iv) an action, including a licensing
12 action, taken during the period described
13 in subparagraph (C) relating to the appli-
14 cation of sanctions described in subpara-
15 graph (B) with respect to crude oil, petro-
16 leum products, natural gas, or other en-
17 ergy products of Russian Federation ori-
18 gin.”; and

19 (2) by adding at the end the following:

20 “(C) PERIOD FOR REVIEW FOR ENERGY-
21 RELATED ACTIONS.—The period described in
22 this subparagraph is the period—

23 “(i) beginning on the date of the en-
24 actment of this subparagraph; and

1 “(ii) ending on the date on which the
2 Secretary of State, in consultation with the
3 Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of
4 Defense, and the Director of National In-
5 telligence, certifies to the appropriate con-
6 gressional committees and leadership that
7 the Government of the Russian Federation
8 has ended its war in Ukraine and credibly
9 committed to a just peace settlement that
10 includes compensating Ukraine for war
11 damages.”.

12 (c) EXCEPTION TO TAKE ACTION DURING INITIAL
13 CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW PERIOD.—Section 216(b)(3) of
14 the Countering America’s Adversaries Through Sanctions
15 Act (22 U.S.C. 9511(b)(3)) is amended—

16 (1) by striking “unless a joint resolution” and
17 inserting the following: “unless—

18 “(A) a joint resolution”;

19 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
20 ing “; or”; and

21 (3) by adding at the end the following:

22 “(B) the action relates to crude oil, petro-
23 leum products, natural gas, or other energy
24 products of Russian Federation origin to be
25 used—

1 “(i) for the preservation of the health
2 or safety of the crew of an energy trans-
3 port vessel;
4 “(ii) for emergency repairs or environ-
5 mental mitigation or protection activities
6 relating to an energy transport vessel; or
7 “(iii) to address an urgent need to
8 mitigate an economic impact in a foreign
9 jurisdiction other than the Russian Fed-
10 eration.”.
