Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 117–13 Offered by Mr. Khanna of California

At the appropriate place in subtitle C of title XIII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 13____. PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT OR MILITARY PAR 2 TICIPATION AGAINST THE HOUTHIS.

3 (a) PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO SECURITY CO-4 OPERATION.—No Federal funds may be made available to 5 provide the following forms of United States support to 6 the armed forces of Saudi Arabia or other members of 7 the Saudi-led coalition, or to implement any United States 8 government contract for such armed forces, in relation to 9 certain military operations in Yemen:

10 (1) Sharing intelligence for the purpose of ena-11 bling coalition strikes against the Houthis in Yemen.

(2) Providing logistical support in the form of
maintenance or the transfer of spare parts for aircraft that enable coalition strikes against the
Houthis in Yemen and its territorial waters, including strikes on Yemen's health care facilities, food
production facilities, schools, airports, and other civilian infrastructure.

1 (b) PROHIBITION ON UNITED STATES MILITARY 2 PARTICIPATION.—No Federal funds may be made available for any of the United States Armed Forces to com-3 4 mand, coordinate, participate in the movement of, or ac-5 company the regular or irregular military forces of the 6 Saudi-led coalition forces in hostilities against the Houthis 7 in Yemen, or in situations in which there exists an immi-8 nent threat that such coalition forces become engaged in 9 such hostilities, unless and until the President has obtained specific statutory authorization in accordance with 10 11 section 8(a) of the War Powers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1547(a)). 12

(c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—The prohibitions
under this section may not be construed to apply with respect to United States Armed Forces engaged in operations directed at al Qaeda or associated forces.
