## OFFERED BY MR. KHANNA OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following:

1	SEC. 3 PROHIBITION ON WASTE INCINERATION OF
2	PFAS.
3	Section 3004 of the Solid Waste Disposal Act (42
4	U.S.C. 6924) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5	lowing new subsection:
6	"(z) PFAS Wastes.—
7	"(1) Firefighting foam.—Not later than 6
8	months after the date of enactment of this sub-
9	section, the Administrator shall promulgate regula-
10	tions prohibiting the disposal by incineration of fire-
11	fighting foam containing PFAS, which prohibition
12	shall take effect not later than 9 months after the
13	date of enactment of this subsection.
14	"(2) Other Pfas Wastes.—
15	"(A) Identification and prohibi-
16	TION.—Not later than 12 months after the date
17	of enactment of this subsection, the Adminis-
18	trator shall promulgate regulations—

1	"(i) identifying additional wastes con-
2	taining PFAS for which a prohibition or
3	incineration may be necessary to protect
4	human health and the environment; and
5	"(ii) prohibiting the disposal by incin-
6	eration of such identified wastes beginning
7	not later than 18 months after the date of
8	enactment of this subsection.
9	"(B) REVIEW AND REVISION.—The Ad-
10	ministrator shall review and revise the list of
11	wastes identified under this paragraph as need-
12	ed, but not less frequently than every 4 years
13	"(3) Penalties.—For purposes of section
14	3008(d), a waste subject to a prohibition under this
15	subsection shall be considered a hazardous waste
16	identified or listed under this subtitle.
17	"(4) Definition.—In this subsection, the term
18	'PFAS' means a perfuoroalkyl or polyfluoroalky
19	substance with at least 1 fully fluorinated carbon
20	atom ''
