At the end of subtitle B of title VII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 7____. ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL INTREPID CEN 2 TER OF EXCELLENCE.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 55 of title 10, United
4 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1073f
5 the following new section:

6 "§ 1073g. National Intrepid Center of Excellence

7 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall
8 establish and maintain the National Intrepid Center of
9 Excellence (in this section referred to as the 'Center') as
10 a program of record subject to milestone reviews and com11 pliance with the requirements under this section.

12 "(b) DUTIES.—The duties of the Center are as fol-13 lows:

"(1) To provide interdisciplinary care to prevent, diagnose, treat, and rehabilitate members of
the armed forces with traumatic brain injury, posttraumatic stress disorder, symptoms from blast over-

pressure or blast exposure, and other mental health
 conditions.

3 "(2) Support and conduct research and edu-4 cation on traumatic brain injury, post-traumatic 5 stress disorder, blast overpressure or blast exposure, 6 and other mental health conditions. 7 "(c) CHILD CARE.—Child care services shall be made 8 available for individuals seeking help through the National Intrepid Center of Excellence. 9 "(d) ANNUAL REPORT.— 10 11 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services 12

of the Senate and the House of Representatives an
annual report that shall include, for the year covered
by the report—

16 "(A) the number of individuals to whom17 the Center has provided services;

18 "(B) the number of individuals who return
19 to active duty in the armed forces after receiv20 ing services from the Center, and the stage in
21 their career at which they seek treatment at the
22 Center;

23 "(C) the number of individuals whose fam24 ilies are able to participate in programs pro25 vided by the Center; and

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"(D) the number of individuals on a
 waitlist for treatment at the Center and the av erage period those individuals are on the
 waitlist.

5 "(2) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of
6 Defense shall make the information contained in
7 each report submitted under paragraph (1) available
8 to the public, including on the govinfo.gov website,
9 or successor website, not later than 10 days after
10 the report is submitted under such paragraph.".

(b) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Secretary of Defense
shall carry out section 1073g of title 10, United States
Code, not later than 120 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
