Page 971, strike lines 1 through 8, and insert the following new subparagraphs (and redesignate the subsequent subparagraph accordingly):

1                   (F) An identification of any challenges in  
2                   establishing an integrated air and missile de-  
3                   fense architecture with specified foreign part-  
4                   ners, including assessments of the capacity of  
5                   specified foreign partners to—

6                   (i) rapidly share and respond to intel-  
7                   ligence on ballistic and cruise missiles,  
8                   manned and unmanned aerial systems, and  
9                   rocket attacks from Iran, and their ability  
10                  to develop such capacity independent of di-  
11                  rect United States support and oversight;

12                  (ii) independently operate key tech-  
13                  nical components of such an architecture,  
14                  including satellite sensors, ground- or sea-  
15                  based radars, and interceptors; and

1 (iii) operate command and control  
2 centers directing the operation of such an  
3 architecture.

4 (G) An assessment of the overall cost to  
5 the United States for providing support for the  
6 establishment and sustainment of such an ar-  
7 chitecture over 5 and 10-year periods.

8 (H) A description of relevant coordination  
9 with the Secretary of State and the ways in  
10 which such an architecture advances United  
11 States regional diplomatic goals and objectives.
