

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-9**  
**OFFERED BY MR. KILDEE OF MICHIGAN**

Page 1549, after line 8, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 12022. HOUSEHOLD WELL WATER TESTING WEBSITE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one year after the  
3 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the  
4 Environmental Protection Agency shall establish a website  
5 containing information relating to the testing of household  
6 well water.

7 (b) CONTENTS.—The Administrator shall include on  
8 the website established under subsection (a) the following:

9 (1) Information on how to get drinking water  
10 tested for a home served by an individual private  
11 well.

12 (2) A list of laboratories that analyze water  
13 samples and are certified by a State or the Adminis-  
14 trator.

15 (3) State-specific information, developed in co-  
16 ordination with each State, on naturally occurring  
17 and human-induced contaminants.

18 (4) Information that, using accepted risk com-  
19 munication techniques, clearly communicates wheth-

1 er a test result value exceeds a level determined by  
2 the Administrator or the State to pose a health risk.

3 (5) Information on treatment options, including  
4 information relating to water treatment systems cer-  
5 tified by the National Sanitation Foundation, Un-  
6 derwriters Laboratories, and the Water Quality As-  
7 sociation.

8 (6) A directory of whom to contact to report a  
9 test result value that exceeds a level determined by  
10 the Administrator or the State to pose a health risk.

11 (7) Information on financial assistance that is  
12 available for homeowners to support water treat-  
13 ment, including grants under section 306E of the  
14 Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act (7  
15 U.S.C. 1926e) and State resources.

16 (8) Any other information the Administrator  
17 considers appropriate.

18 (c) COORDINATION.—The Administrator shall coordi-  
19 nate with the Secretary of Health and Human Services,  
20 the Secretary of Agriculture, and appropriate State agen-  
21 cies in carrying out this section.

22 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is  
23 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
24 \$1,000,000 for fiscal year 2022.
