## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-19

OFFERED BY MR. KILMER OF WASHINGTON

At the end of title XI, add the following:

## 1 SEC. 1113. ASSESSMENT OF ACCELERATED PROMOTION 2 PROGRAM SUSPENSION.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the 4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the 5 Navy shall enter into an agreement with a Federally fund-6 ed research and development center with relevant expertise 7 to conduct an assessment of the impacts resulting from the Navy's suspension in 2016 of the Accelerated Pro-8 motion Program (in this section referred to as the 9 10 "APP").

11 (b) ELEMENTS.—The assessment required under12 subsection (a) shall include the following elements:

(1) An identification of the employees who were
hired at the four public shipyards between January
23, 2016, and December 22, 2016, covering the period in which APP was suspended, and who would
have otherwise been eligible for APP had the program been in effect at the time they were hired.

1 (2) An assessment for each employee identified 2 in paragraph (1) to determine the difference between 3 wages earned from the date of hire to the date on 4 which the wage data would be collected and the 5 wages which would have been earned during this 6 same period should that employee have participated 7 in APP from the date of hire and been promoted ac-8 cording to the average promotion timeframe for par-9 ticipants hired in the five-year period prior to the 10 suspension.

(3) An assessment for each employee identified
in paragraph (1) to determine at what grade and
step each effected employee would be at on October
1, 2020, had that employee been promoted according
to the average promotion timeframe for participants
hired in the five-year period prior to the suspension.

17 (4) An evaluation of existing authorities avail-18 able to the Secretary to determine whether the Sec-19 retary can take measures using those authorities to 20 provide the pay difference and corresponding inter-21 est, at a rate of the federal short-term interest rate 22 plus 3 percent, to each effected employee identified 23 in paragraph (2) and directly promote the employee 24 to the grade and step identified in paragraph (3).

(c) REPORT.—The Secretary shall submit to the con gressional defense committees a report on the results of
 the evaluation by not later than June 1, 2020, and shall
 provide interim briefings upon request.
