

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8294, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. KILMER OF WASHINGTON**

Page 120, after line 9, insert the following:

1 “(E) HIGH SCHOOL PRIZE COMPETI-
2 TION.—To establish a prize competition for
3 high schools, which—

4 “(i) meets the requirements of section
5 24 of the Stevenson-Wylder Technology In-
6 novation Act of 1980 (15 U.S.C.12 3719);

7 “(ii) prepares high school students to
8 enter and succeed in an in-demand indus-
9 try sector or occupation, including manu-
10 facturing, information technology, com-
11 puter science, cybersecurity, health care,
12 energy, green jobs, advanced manufac-
13 turing, and other sectors identified by the
14 Administrator and the Advisory Committee
15 as technology innovation sectors; and

16 “(iii) targets individuals with barriers
17 to employment in youth apprenticeship or
18 pre-apprenticeship programs, prioritizing
19 nontraditional apprenticeship populations
20 such as women, minorities, individuals with

1 a disability, individuals experiencing home-
2 lessness, individuals impacted by the crimi-
3 nal or juvenile justice system, and foster
4 and former foster youth.”.
