### **AMENDMENT TO H. J. RES. \_\_\_\_\_**

#### **OFFERED BY MR. KING OF IOWA**

At the end of the joint resolution (before the short title), insert the following:

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. (a) No funds, resources or fees made  
2 available to the Secretary of Homeland Security, or to any  
3 other official of a Federal agency, by this joint resolution  
4 or any other Act for any fiscal year, including any deposits  
5 into the “Immigration Examinations Fee Account” estab-  
6 lished under section 286(m) of the Immigration and Na-  
7 tionality Act (8 USC 1356(m)), may be used to consider  
8 or adjudicate any new, renewal or previously denied appli-  
9 cation for any alien requesting consideration of deferred  
10 action, as authorized by any of the following (or any sub-  
11 stantially similar policy changes issued or taken on or  
12 after April 27, 2017, whether set forth in memorandum,  
13 Executive order, regulation, directive, or by other action):

14           (1) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
15 Homeland Security entitled “Exercising Prosecu-  
16 torial Discretion with Respect to Individuals Who  
17 Came to the United States as Children” dated June  
18 15, 2012.

1           (2) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
2           Homeland Security entitled “Exercising Prosecu-  
3           torial Discretion with Respect to Individuals Who  
4           Came to the United States as Children and with Re-  
5           spect to Certain Individuals Who Are the Parents of  
6           U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents” dated No-  
7           vember 20, 2014.

8           (b) The budgetary effects of this section shall not be  
9           entered on either PAYGO scorecard maintained pursuant  
10          to section 4(d) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of  
11          2010.

12          (c) Notwithstanding Rule 3 of the Budget  
13          Scorekeeping Guidelines set forth in the joint explanatory  
14          statement of the committee of conference accompanying  
15          Conference Report 105-217 and section 250(c)(8) of the  
16          Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of  
17          1985, the budgetary effects of this section shall not be  
18          estimated—

19                 (1) for purposes of section 251 of the such Act;  
20          and

21                 (2) for purposes of paragraph 4(C) of section 3  
22          of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010 as  
23          being included in an appropriation Act.
