

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-

22

OFFERED BY MR. KINZINGER OF ILLINOIS

At the end of title VII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7_____ REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL MOBILE SUB-**
2 **SCRIBER IDENTITY-CATCHERS AND UNITED**
3 **STATES NATIONAL SECURITY.**

4 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director
6 of National Intelligence, in consultation with the Secretary
7 of Homeland Security, the Director of the Federal Bureau
8 of Investigation, and the heads of other agencies the Di-
9 rector of National Intelligence determines appropriate,
10 shall submit to the congressional intelligence committees
11 a report describing—

12 (1) the threats that international mobile sub-
13 scriber identity-catchers pose to national security
14 and, specifically, the safety and security of Govern-
15 ment personnel;

16 (2) the prevalence of international mobile sub-
17 scriber identity-catchers used by both foreign actors

1 and domestic law enforcement within the United
2 States;

3 (3) actions taken by Federal agencies, as of the
4 date of the report, to remove or neutralize inter-
5 national mobile subscriber identity-catchers installed
6 by foreign entities, with a primary focus on the Na-
7 tional Capital Region (as defined in section 2674(f)
8 of title 10, United States Code);

9 (4) policy recommendations for Congress to
10 consider that would empower law enforcement and
11 the intelligence community to counter such foreign
12 intelligence operations while minimizing interference
13 with legitimate domestic law enforcement operations;

14 (5) the extent to which private entities, as well
15 as Federal entities not primarily responsible for na-
16 tional security or homeland security, are able to re-
17 move, neutralize, or otherwise render ineffective
18 international mobile subscriber identity-catchers; and

19 (6) recommendations for new software pro-
20 grams, or the hardening of existing software pro-
21 grams, to reduce mobile phone susceptibility to
22 international mobile subscriber identity-catchers.

23 (b) FORM.—To the extent practicable, the report
24 shall be submitted in an unclassified, law enforcement sen-
25 sitive form for the purposes of distribution to other con-

1 gressional committees, but may also include a classified
2 annex.
