9 (1) condition receipt of universal service sup-10 port under section 254 of the Communications Act 11 of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254) by a provider of broadband 12 internet access service on the regulation of the rates 13 charged by such provider for the supported service; 14 or  $\mathbf{2}$ 

1 (2) enforce subpart Y of part 64 of title 47, 2 Code of Federal Regulations (relating to truth-in-3 billing requirements). (c) In this section— 4 (1) the term "broadband internet access serv-5 6 ice" has the meaning given such term in section 8.1 of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations; 7 (2) the term "rate" means the amount charged 8 9 by a provider of broadband internet access service 10 for the delivery of broadband internet traffic; and (3) the term "regulation" or "regulate" means, 11 12 with respect to a rate, the use by the Federal Com-13 munications Commission of rulemaking or enforce-14 ment authority to establish, declare, or review the reasonableness of such rate. 15
