## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-13

## OFFERED BY MR. KRISHNAMOORTHI OF ILLINOIS

At the end of subtitle C of title VII, insert the following:

1	SEC. 7 AUTHORITY TO DONATE SYRINGES AND COVID-
2	19 VACCINES TO CERTAIN ALLIES AND PART-
3	NERS OF THE UNITED STATES PRIOR TO EX-
4	PIRATION.

5 (a) AUTHORITY.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense 6 7 may accept from a State a syringe or dose of vaccine 8 for COVID-19 that has been licensed under section 9 351 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 10 262), or authorized for emergency use under section 11 564 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act 12 (21 U.S.C. 360bbb–3), and provide such syringe or 13 dose to an overseas ally or partner of the United 14 States (at no cost to the ally or partner), if the Sec-15 retary determines that the ally or partner is 16 logistically capable of receiving, and administering or 17 distributing (as applicable), such syringe or dose 18 prior to the date of expiration.

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1 (2) HUMANITARIAN CONSIDERATION.—In 2 prioritizing the provision of syringes and doses to 3 overseas allies and partners under subsection (a), 4 the Secretary shall take into consideration the pov-5 erty level of the ally or partner.

6 (b) PLAN.—Not later than 90 days after the date of 7 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall 8 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a plan 9 to implement an overseas donation program pursuant to 10 the authority under subsection (a), taking into consider-11 ation the poverty level of prospective recipients under such 12 program as specified in subsection (a)(2).

(c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congressional committees" means—

- 16 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
  17 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep18 resentatives; and
- (2) the Committee on Armed Services and theCommittee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.

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
