SEC. 509. (a) IN GENERAL.—Title I of the Ethics
 in Government Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App. 101 et seq.)
 is amended by adding after section 111 the following:

## 4 "§ 112. Recusal for conflicts of interest

5 "(a) An officer or employee of the Executive Office 6 of the President or the White House who is recused from 7 a particular matter by operation of section 208 of title 8 18, United States Code, shall, not later than 10 business 9 days after such recusal, provide notification (in writing) 10 of such recusal and the specific reasons for the recusal 11 to—

- 12 "(1) the Director of the Office of Government13 Ethics;
- "(2) the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform of the House of Representatives; and
  "(3) the Committee on Homeland Security and
  Governmental Affairs of the Senate.

18 "(b) With respect to any instance in which an officer19 or employee of the Executive Office of the President or

1 the White House notifies the designated agency ethics offi2 cial of a future particular matter that may require recusal
3 under section 208 of title 18, United States Code, the offi4 cer or employee shall provide a report to the entities listed

7 "(1) the particular matter;

8 "(2) whether the designated agency ethics offi-9 cial advised the officer or employee that the officer 10 or employee should not participate in the particular 11 matter; and

"(3) whether the particular matter occurred.".
(b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall apply to any recusal pursuant to section
208 of title 18, United States Code, occurring on or after
the date of enactment of this Act.
