(2) Costs, risks, benefits, and opportunities associated with conversion of installation electrical
grids to support solar power.

3 (5) The applicability of solar power based on
4 geographic location of Department installations.

5 (6) The actions and timelines that would be re6 quired to implement solar power across all Depart7 ment installations and facilities that the study may

9 (7) The applicability of residential solar power
10 on homes and properties within the Department of
11 Defense Housing Network.

(c) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
to Congress a report on the study under this section.
