

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. KUSTER OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

At the end of the bill, adding the following section:

1 SEC. 7. COLLECTION OF OVERDOSE DATA.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years after the
3 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
4 Human Services shall commence a study on how to most
5 efficiently track overdoses by type of drug, including
6 fentanyl.

7 (b) GRANT PROGRAM.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Upon completion of the
9 study under subsection (a), and taking into consider-
10 ation the results of such study, the Secretary of
11 Health and Human Services shall award grants to
12 States to facilitate the collection of data with respect
13 to fentanyl-involved overdoses.

14 (2) REQUIREMENT.—As a condition on receipt
15 of a grant under this subsection, an applicant shall
16 agree to share the data collected pursuant to the
17 grant with the Centers for Disease Control and Pre-
18 vention.

19 (3) PREFERENCE.—In awarding grants under
20 this subsection, the Secretary of Health and Human

- 1 Services shall give preference to applicants whose
- 2 grant proposals demonstrate the greatest need for
- 3 collecting timely and accurate data on overdoses.
