

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116–19
OFFERED BY MS. KUSTER OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

At the end of subtitle C of title V, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 530. TRAINING OF MEMBERS OF BOARDS FOR COR-**
2 **RECTION OF MILITARY RECORDS AND DIS-**
3 **CHARGE REVIEW BOARDS ON SEXUAL TRAU-**
4 **MA, INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE, SPOUSAL**
5 **ABUSE, AND RELATED MATTERS.**

6 (a) **BOARDS FOR CORRECTION OF MILITARY**
7 **RECORDS.**—The curriculum of training for members of
8 boards for the correction of military records under section
9 534(e) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fis-
10 cal Year 2017 (10 U.S.C. 1552 note) shall include train-
11 ing on each of the following:

- 12 (1) Sexual trauma.
- 13 (2) Intimate partner violence.
- 14 (3) Spousal abuse.
- 15 (4) The various responses of individuals to
16 trauma.

17 (b) **DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARDS.**—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Each Secretary concerned
2 shall develop and provide training for members of
3 discharge review boards under section 1553 of title
4 10, United States Code, that are under the jurisdic-
5 tion of such Secretary on each of the following:

6 (A) Sexual trauma.

7 (B) Intimate partner violence.

8 (C) Spousal abuse.

9 (D) The various responses of individuals to
10 trauma.

11 (2) UNIFORMITY OF TRAINING.—The Secretary
12 of Defense and the Secretary of Homeland Security
13 shall jointly ensure that the training developed and
14 provided pursuant to this subsection is, to the extent
15 practicable, uniform.

16 (3) SECRETARY CONCERNED DEFINED.—In this
17 subsection, the term “Secretary concerned” has the
18 meaning given that term in section 101(a)(9) of title
19 10, United States Code.
