## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13 OFFERED BY MS. CHU OF CALIFORNIA

Add at the end of subtitle B of title XII of division A the following:

I	SEC. 12 SENSE OF CONGRESS RELATING TO KABUL AIR
2	STRIKE.
3	It is the sense of Congress that—
4	(1) an investigation by the Commander of
5	United States Central Command, General Kenneth
6	F. McKenzie, found that an August air strike in
7	Kabul resulted in the deaths of as many as ten civil-
8	ians, including up to seven children;
9	(2) Secretary of Defense, Lloyd J. Austin III,
10	expressed condolences to the surviving family mem-
11	bers on behalf of the Department of Defense;
12	(3) senior defense officials must ensure that
13	there is full accountability for this tragic mistake;
14	(4) the Department of Defense must conduct a
15	timely, comprehensive, and transparent investigation
16	into the events that led to the deaths of innocent ci-
17	vilians, including accountability measures to be
18	taken and consideration of the degree to which

strike authorities, procedures, and processes need to

be altered in the future; and

(5) while no amount of recompense can make

up for the loss or grief of the affected families, the

United States must provide appropriate compensa
tion for those families through the form of ex gratia

payments or other means of remuneration.
