AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 115–23 OFFERED BY MR. KHANNA OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle G of title XII, add the following:

1	SEC. 12 PROHIBITION ON REFUELING FOR MISSIONS
2	OVER NORTHERN AND WESTERN YEMEN.
3	(a) In General.—None of the funds authorized to
4	be appropriated by this Act are authorized to be made
5	available for the refueling of the aircraft of Saudi Arabia
6	or its military coalition partners in Yemen (in this section
7	collectively referred to as "the coalition") for any mission
8	conducted over Northern or Western Yemen until the date
9	specified in subsection (c), unless the Secretary of Defense
10	certifies to the congressional defense committees that—
11	(1) such mission will not take any action
12	against a location included on any "no-strike" list
13	provided to the coalition by the United States and
14	will not conduct any airstrike on a civilian target; or
15	(2) such mission is vital to the national security
16	interests of the United States.
17	(b) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the date
18	of the enactment of this Act, and every 90 days thereafter
19	until the date specified in subsection (c), the Secretary of

1	Defense shall submit to the congressional defense commit-
2	tees a report describing—
3	(1) each instance in which the Secretary of De-
4	fense provided a certification under subsection (a)(1)
5	with respect to a mission and subsequently obtained
6	information confirming that such mission took an
7	action against a location included on a "no-strike"
8	list or conducted an airstrike on a civilian target;
9	(2) any action taken by the Secretary of De-
10	fense in response to such confirmation; and
11	(3) as applicable, the response of the coalition
12	to the action taken by the Secretary of Defense.
13	(c) TERMINATION DATE SPECIFIED.—The date spec-
14	ified in this subsection is the date that is 3 years after
15	the date of the enactment of this Act.
