

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 115-23**  
**OFFERED BY MR. KHANNA OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle H of title XII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 12 . INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE IF EMPLOYEES**  
2 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE VIOLATED FEDERAL LAW OR DEPARTMENT OF**  
3 **DEFENSE POLICY WHILE CONDUCTING OPERATIONS IN YEMEN.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall  
7 conduct an investigation to determine if employees of the  
8 Department of Defense violated Federal law or Department of Defense policy while conducting operations in  
9 Yemen.

11 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The investigation  
12 required under subsection (a) shall also seek to determine  
13 the following:

14 (1) Whether any Department of Defense personnel interrogated Yemeni citizens in prisons within  
15 Yemen or provided questions to foreign personnel for use in such interrogations of Yemeni citizens, and  
16 whether such interrogations or actions were consistent with United States law and policy.

1           (2) Whether any Department of Defense per-  
2           sonnel violated the prohibitions of section 362 of  
3           title 10, United States Code, while conducting oper-  
4           ations in Yemen.

5           (c) REPORT.—

6           (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days  
7           after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
8           retary of Defense shall submit to the Committee on  
9           Armed Services of the Senate and the Committee on  
10          Armed Services of the House of Representatives a  
11          report that contains the findings of the investigation  
12          required under subsection (a).

13          (2) FORM.—The report required by this sub-  
14          section shall be submitted in unclassified form, but  
15          may contain a classified annex.
