

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-

38

OFFERED BY MR. LALOTA OF NEW YORK

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1 SEC. _____. (a) Not later than 90 days after the en-
2 actment of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Secretary
3 of Homeland Security shall submit to the Committees on
4 Appropriations, the Committee on Homeland Security of
5 the House of Representatives, and the Committee on
6 Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Sen-
7 ate a report on the redeployment of law enforcement
8 agents from areas between ports of entry to ports of entry
9 and processing centers.

10 (b) The report shall include—

11 (1) the total number of law enforcement agents
12 assigned to areas between ports of entry as of the
13 date of the enactment of this Act;

14 (2) the total number of law enforcement agents
15 assigned to ports of entry and processing centers as
16 of the date of the enactment of this Act; and

17 (3) the number of law enforcement agents who
18 have been reassigned from areas between ports of

1 entry to ports of entry and processing centers during
2 the period beginning January 20, 2020, and ending
3 on the date of the enactment of this Act.

4 (c) In this section:

5 (1) The term “law enforcement agents” in-
6 cludes all personnel involved in border security oper-
7 ations, including but not limited to, U.S. Customs
8 and Border Protection officers, U.S. Border Patrol
9 agents, and other relevant Department of Homeland
10 Security personnel.

11 (2) The term “areas between ports of entry”
12 refers to locations along the borders of the United
13 States that are not designated as official points of
14 entry.
