(a) Not later than 90 days after the en-2 actment of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Secretary 3 of Homeland Security shall submit to the Committees on 4 Appropriations, the Committee on Homeland Security of 5 the House of Representatives, and the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Sen-6 ate a report on the redeployment of law enforcement 7 8 agents from areas between ports of entry to ports of entry 9 and processing centers.

10 (b) The report shall include—

(1) the total number of law enforcement agents
assigned to areas between ports of entry as of the
date of the enactment of this Act;

(2) the total number of law enforcement agents
assigned to ports of entry and processing centers as
of the date of the enactment of this Act; and

17 (3) the number of law enforcement agents who18 have been reassigned from areas between ports of

entry to ports of entry and processing centers during
 the period beginning January 20, 2020, and ending
 on the date of the enactment of this Act.

5 (1) The term "law enforcement agents" in-6 cludes all personnel involved in border security oper-7 ations, including but not limited to, U.S. Customs 8 and Border Protection officers, U.S. Border Patrol 9 agents, and other relevant Department of Homeland 10 Security personnel.

(2) The term "areas between ports of entry"
refers to locations along the borders of the United
States that are not designated as official points of
entry.
