

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 1446
OFFERED BY MR. LAMALFA OF CALIFORNIA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Lawful Ammunition
3 and Weapons Act of 2021”.

4 SEC. 2. UNLAWFUL ACTS.

5 Section 922 of title 18, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a), by striking paragraphs
8 (3) and (5); and

9 (2) in subsection (b), by striking paragraphs
10 (2) and (3).

11 SEC. 3. INTERSTATE PURCHASE PROTECTION.

12 Chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, is amend-
13 ed by inserting after section 922 the following:

14 “§ 922A. Interstate Purchase Protection

15 “(a) Nothing in section 922 shall prevent an other-
16 wise eligible United States citizen from purchasing any le-
17 gally available firearm in any State, territory, or district
18 of the United States as long as—

1 “(1) the purchase takes place in person;

2 “(2) the purchase is from a licensed importer,
3 licensed manufacturer, licensed dealer, or licensed
4 collector; and

5 “(3) the purchase is otherwise lawful in accord-
6 ance with section 922.

7 “(b) If lawfully purchased in any State, territory, or
8 district of the United States the possession, transpor-
9 tation, or use of a firearm or ammunition feeding device,
10 magazine or ammunition shall be lawful in all other
11 States, territories, and districts of the United States and
12 may not be restricted or registered unless otherwise re-
13 quired by section 922.

14 “(c) Except for the restrictions listed in section 922
15 there shall be no allowable restrictions on the possession,
16 purchase or shipment of ammunition, ammunition feeding
17 device, or magazine, including across State lines.”.

18 **SEC. 4. RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

19 Section 926 of title 18, United States Code, is
20 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
21 section:

22 “(d) No agency of Government, State, territory, dis-
23 trict of the United States or subdivision there of may cre-
24 ate or maintain any system of registration of firearms,
25 firearms owners, firearms transactions, ammunition pur-

1 chases, magazine purchases, ammunition feeding device
2 purchases or dispositions be established. The ownership of
3 firearms, ammunition, magazines, and ammunition feed-
4 ing devices shall not be tracked in any way.”.

5 **SEC. 5. INTERSTATE TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS.**

6 Section 926A of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended—

8 (1) by striking “Notwithstanding any other pro-
9 vision of any law or any rule or regulation of a State
10 or any political subdivision thereof, any” and insert-
11 ing “If lawfully purchased in any State, territory, or
12 district of the United States the possession, trans-
13 portation, or use of any firearm or ammunition feed-
14 ing devices, magazines or ammunition for a lawful
15 sporting purpose or for self-defense is lawful in all
16 other States, territories, or districts of the United
17 States and may not be restricted or registered by
18 any State or local subdivision thereof. Any”;

19 (2) by striking “from any place where he may
20 lawfully possess and carry such firearm to any other
21 place where he may lawfully possess” after “firearm
22 for any lawful purpose”; and

23 (3) by adding at the end the following: “For
24 purposes of this section, the term ‘transportation’
25 includes staying in temporary lodging overnight,

1 stopping for food, fuel, vehicle maintenance, an
2 emergency, medical treatment, and any other activ-
3 ity incidental to the transport.”.
