Subtitle D—Wildland Firefighter Recognition

3 SEC. 931. DEFINITIONS.

4 In this subtitle:

(1) DIRECTOR.—The term "Director" means 5 the Director of the Office of Personnel Management. 6 (2) EMPLOYEE.—The term "employee" has the 7 meaning given the term in section 2105 of title 5, 8 9 United States Code. 10 (3) FEDERAL LAND MANAGEMENT AGENCY. 11 the term "Federal land management agency" 12 means-

13 (A) within the Department of the Inte14 rior—

- 15 (i) the Bureau of Land Management;
- 16 (ii) the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
- 17 (iii) the National Park Service; and

1	(iv) the United States Fish and Wild-
2	life Service; and
3	(B) within the Department of Agriculture,
4	the Forest Service.
5	(4) WILDLAND FIRE.—The term "wildland
6	fire" means any non-structure fire that occurs in
7	vegetation or natural fuels, including prescribed fire
8	and wildfire.
9	(5) WILDAND FIREFIGHTER.—The term
10	"wildland firefighter" means—
11	(A) an employee of a Federal land man-
12	agement agency, the duties of whose position
13	are primarily to perform work directly related
14	to the prevention, control, suppression, manage-
15	ment of wildland fires, or support of wildland
16	fire activities; and
17	(B) an employee of a Federal land man-
18	agement agency who is transferred to a super-
19	visory or administrative position from a position
20	described in subparagraph (A).
21	SEC. 2. CLASSIFICATION OF WILDLAND FIREFIGHTERS.
22	(a) IN GENERAL.—
23	(1) DEVELOPMENT OF OCCUPATIONAL SERIES
24	REQUIRED.—Not later than 30 days after the date
25	of enactment of this Act, the Director, in coopera-

tion with the Federal land management agencies,
 shall carry out a distinct wildland firefighter occupa tional series that more accurately reflects the variety
 of duties performed by wildland firefighters.
 (2) DESIGNATION.—The official title assigned

to any occupational series established under paragraph (1) shall include the designation of "Wildland
Firefighter".

9 (3) POSITIONS DESCRIBED.—Paragraph (1) 10 shall apply with respect to any class or other cat-11 egory of positions that consists primarily or exclu-12 sively of forestry technician positions, range techni-13 cian positions, or any other positions the duties and 14 responsibilities of which include—

15 (A) significant prevention, preparedness,
16 control, suppression, or management activities
17 for wildland fires; or

(B) activities necessary to meet any otheremergency incident to which assigned.

(4) CONSULTATION.—It is the sense of Congress that the Director should consult with employee
associations and any other groups that represent
wildland firefighters in carrying out this subsection.
(5) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 2 years

25 after the date of enactment of this Act—

1 (A) the Director shall complete the devel-2 opment of the wildland firefighter occupational series required under paragraph (1); and 3 4 (B) the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture shall use the wildland 5 6 firefighter occupational series developed under 7 paragraph (1) in the advertising and hiring of 8 a wildland firefighter. 9 (b) HAZARDOUS DUTY DIFFERENTIAL NOT AF-FECTED.—Section 5545(d)(1) of title 5, United States 10 Code, is amended by striking "except in such cir-11 12 cumstances as the Office may by regulation prescribe; 13 and" and inserting the following: "except— 14 "(A) with respect to an employee in an oc-15 cupational series covering positions for which 16 the primary duties involve the prevention, con-17 trol, suppression, or management of wildland 18 fires, as determined by the Office; and 19 "(B) in such other circumstances as the 20 Office may by regulation prescribe; and". 21 (c) CURRENT EMPLOYEES.—Any individual employed 22 as a wildland firefighter on the date on which the occupa-23 tional series established pursuant to subsection (a) takes

24 effect may elect to—

(1) remain in the occupational series in which
 the individual is working; or

3 (2) be included in the wildland firefighter occu4 pational series established pursuant to subsection
5 (a).
