1 **SEC. ____ . SANTA YNEZ BAND OF CHUMASH INDIANS LAND**
2 **AFFIRMATION.**

3 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This section may be cited as the
4 “Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians Land Affirmation
5 Act of 2019”.

6 (b) **FINDINGS.**—Congress finds the following:

7 (1) On October 13, 2017, the General Council
8 of the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians voted
9 to approve the Memorandum of Agreement between
10 the County of Santa Barbara and the Santa Ynez
11 Band of Chumash Indians regarding the approxi-
12 mately 1,427.28 acres of land, commonly known as
13 Camp 4, and authorized the Tribal Chairman to sign
14 the Memorandum of Agreement.

15 (2) On October 31, 2017, the Board of Super-
16 visors for the County of Santa Barbara approved the
17 Memorandum of Agreement on Camp 4 and author-
18 ized the Chair to sign the Memorandum of Agree-
19 ment.

1 (3) The Secretary of the Interior approved the
2 Memorandum of Agreement pursuant to section
3 2103 of the Revised Statutes (25 U.S.C. 81).

4 (c) LAND TO BE TAKEN INTO TRUST.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—The approximately 1,427.28
6 acres of land in Santa Barbara County, CA de-
7 scribed in paragraph (3), is hereby taken into trust
8 for the benefit of the Tribe, subject to valid existing
9 rights, contracts, and management agreements re-
10 lated to easements and rights-of-way.

11 (2) ADMINISTRATION.—

12 (A) ADMINISTRATION.—The land described
13 in paragraph (3) shall be a part of the Santa
14 Ynez Indian Reservation and administered in
15 accordance with the laws and regulations gen-
16 erally applicable to the land held in trust by the
17 United States for an Indian tribe.

18 (B) EFFECT.—For purposes of certain
19 California State laws (including the California
20 Land Conservation Act of 1965, Government
21 Code Section 51200, et seq.), placing the land
22 described in paragraph (3) into trust shall re-
23 move any restrictions on the property pursuant
24 to California Government Code Section 51295
25 or any other provision of such Act.

1 (3) LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF LANDS TRANS-
2 FERRED.—The lands to be taken into trust for the
3 benefit of the Tribe pursuant to this Act are de-
4 scribed as follows:

11 (4) RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in
12 this section shall—

13 (A) enlarge, impair, or otherwise affect any
14 right or claim of the Tribe to any land or inter-
15 est in land that is in existence before the date
16 of the enactment of this Act;

17 (B) affect any water right of the Tribe in
18 existence before the date of the enactment of
19 this Act; or

20 (C) terminate or limit any access in any
21 way to any right-of-way or right-of-use issued,
22 granted, or permitted before the date of the en-
23 actment of this Act.

24 (5) RESTRICTED USE OF TRANSFERRED
25 LANDS.—The Tribe may not conduct, on the land

1 described in paragraph (3) taken into trust for the
2 Tribe pursuant to this section, gaming activities—

3 (A) as a matter of claimed inherent au-
4 thority; or

5 (B) under any Federal law, including the
6 Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C.
7 2701 et seq.) and regulations promulgated by
8 the Secretary or the National Indian Gaming
9 Commission under that Act.

10 (6) DEFINITIONS.—For the purposes of this
11 subsection:

12 (A) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary”
13 means the Secretary of the Interior.

14 (B) TRIBE.—The term “Tribe” means the
15 Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Mission Indians.
