In section 2101, strike subsection (c), relating to study of near-term facility alternatives to house high value detainees, and insert the following new subsection:

1 (c) AUTHORIZED ARMY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT
2 FOR HIGH VALUE DETENTION FACILITY AT GUANTA-
3 NAMO BAY NAVAL BASE, CUBA.—

4 (1) PROJECT AUTHORIZATION.—In addition to
5 the project authorized under subsection (b), using
6 amounts appropriated pursuant to the authorization
7 of appropriations in section 2103(a) and available
8 for military construction projects outside the United
9 States as specified in the funding table in section
10 4601, the Secretary of the Army may carry out a
11 military construction project for a High Value De-
12 tention Facility at Guantanamo Bay Naval Base,
13 Cuba, in the amount of \$88,500,000.

14 (2) REVISION OF FUNDING.—

15 (A) INCREASE.—Notwithstanding the
16 amounts set forth in the funding tables in divi-
17 sion D, the amount authorized to be appro-

1 appropriated in section 2103(a) for military construc-
2 tion projects carried out under this section, as
3 specified in the corresponding funding table in
4 section 4601, is hereby increased by
5 \$88,500,000, to be available for the purpose
6 specified in paragraph (1).

7 (B) DECREASE.—Notwithstanding the
8 amounts set forth in the funding tables in divi-
9 sion D, the amount authorized to be appro-
10 priated in section 301 for operation and main-
11 tenance for Defense-wide, Office of the Sec-
12 retary of Defense, as specified in the cor-
13 responding funding table in section 4301, line
14 460, is hereby reduced by \$88,500,000.
