5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-6 7 retary shall review applicable regulations and revise, as appropriate, those regulations to ensure that indi-8 9 viduals with disabilities who request assistance while 10 traveling in air transportation receive timely and ef-11 fective assistance at airports and on aircraft from 12 trained personnel. Such assistance may be in board-13 ing or deplaning an aircraft, connecting between 14 flights, or other similar or related requests, as ap-15 propriate.

16 (2) TRAINING.—The Secretary shall require air
17 carriers to ensure that personnel, including contrac18 tors, who may be providing physical assistance to a
19 passenger with a disability receive hands-on training

on an annual basis in performing that assistance, in cluding the use of all equipment.

3 (b) REVIEW AND AMENDMENT.—The Secretary shall

8 (1) ACCESS BOARD.—The term "Access Board"

(2) AIR CARRIER.—The term "air carrier"
means an air carrier or foreign air carrier (as those
terms are defined in section 40102(a) of title 49,
United States Code).

(3) DISABILITY.—The term "disability" has the
meaning given that term in section 3 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C.
12102), including the meaning under that section as
amended by the ADA Amendments of 2008 (Public
Law 110–325; 122 Stat. 3553).

21 (4) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
